## HISTORY OF DOWNTOWN SOUNDS


As a way to bring people into the downtown, the Glen Cove Downtown B.I.D. created its first free concert series, Jazz in The Square, in 1997. It was a hit. During the following years, the concert series evolved to accommodate a variety of musical styles that broadened its appeal to residents and visitors alike. Today, Downtown Sounds is jointly produced through a partnership between the Glen Cove Downtown Business Improvement District, the City of Glen Cove and Nassau County.

Glen Cove has a long history of fine musical events, which began in 1959 with the Morgan Park Summer Music Festival. Downtown Sounds and the Downtown B.I.D. continues to fulfill its vision of making Glen Cove the "Music Capital of the North Shore."

Every Friday night during July & August, Village Square comes alive with music featuring East Coast area artists. With the sounds of jazz, rhythm and blues, rock, Latin and other genres filling the air, the public enjoys great music while dancing and dining in our open and inviting downtown area. 
#### PHOEBE PINDER


#### SOFIA SANCHEZ

## THE DOWNTOWN SOUNDS 2023 COMMITTEE

#### FRED GUARING, CHAIRPERSON OF DOVANTOVAN SOUNDS

As the owner and engineer of Tiki Recording Studios, Fred Guarino has been supplying quality services, great equipment, a comfortable recording environment and talented engineers to a plethora of musical acts for the past 40 years. Beginning with an eight-track studio in the basement of his parents' home, it wasn't long before Fred opened shop with a brand new studio that has blossomed as a Glen Cove business since 1983. Indeed, throughout its existence, Tiki has remained at the cutting edge in an industry where recording and technology trends are continually evolving. For example, in 2004, Fred sold his studio to recording artist Alicia Keys and downsized to his current location on Glen Street. The move allowed him to incorporate the most modern technology in a more intimate environment and Tiki Recording now features modern equipment along with traditional analog gear. The combination allows for a hybrid analog/digital recording approach that has been well received by the artists he works with. Over his 40 years, these include Billy Joel, Alicia Keys, Jimmy Webb, Ashanti, Maureen McGovern, Billy J. Kramer, Odetta, Joan Osborne, Phoebe Snow, Peter Allen, Brian Setzer, Kenny Rogers, James Earle Jones, Woody Allen, Andy Cooney and Crystal Gayle. Throughout his career, Fred has earned numerous Grammy nominations for projects he has recorded and in addition to being the chairperson for Downtown Sounds, was National President of the Society of **Professional Recording Studios.** 

#### FRED DIMENNA

During 20 years as a competitor bodybuilder, Fred DiMenna won two amateur drug-free Mr. United States competitions including one that earned him his pro card in 1994. He went on to compete 11 times as a pro including a runner-up placement in the heavyweight class of the 1998 WNBF Pro Natural International. He retired from competition in 2003 and returned to school to pursue his Master's degree in Exercise Physiology at Adelphi University. After graduating with a 4.0, he left native Glen Cove to obtain his PhD at the University of Exeter, the leading university for sports science in the U.K. His PhD supervisor was renowned physiologist Andy Jones and his research was in the field of oxygen uptake kinetics. After returning to the U.S., he has continued to work with the group at Exeter in addition to assuming a position as a Research Associate in the Division of Endocrinology, Diabetes and Bone Disease for the Department of Medicine at Mount Sinai St. Luke's Hospital in Manhattan. He also works with researchers at the Pulmonary Institute at the Chaim Sheba Medical Center in Israel and the Faculdade de Ciências at São Paulo State University in Brazil. Through these affiliations, he has amassed 40 PubMed publications. For the past eight years, he has served as an Adjunct Assistant Professor of Movement Sciences at Columbia University Teachers College while in 2014, he assumed what might be his most daunting challenge yet organizing the chaos at the View Grill, his wife Jeanine's restaurant.

#### KEITH WAY

As a teenager washing dishes in a restaurant in Vermont, Keith Way's journey to the top of the hospitality industry started inauspiciously. However, a few years later, Keith attended the Culinary Institute of America, which paved the way for his future success. At CIA, Keith met Arno Schmidt, who brought him into the Big Apple chapter of the American Culinary Federation. This opened up many job opportunities for Keith who began working as Assistant Steward at the Westbury Hotel. After a month, he was promoted to Chief Steward and after a few years, became Food & Beverage Director and Banquet Manager. He moved on to positions as Banquet Manager at the Park Lane Hotel and U.N. Plaza Hotel where he hosted dignitaries including former President Gerald Ford. After 20 years of working in hotels, Keith wanted to spend more time with his family so he began working for Breakfast Productions, a boutique bread & pastry company that eventually merged with Voila! Bakeries. During his time at Breakfast Productions, Keith was named Purveyor of the Year by the Food & Beverage Association of America. He also worked for three years with Bouley Bakery before retiring. Nowadays, he stays active on the local front helping Chef Jeanine DiMenna with operations at the View Grill and, of course, also dedicates his time and energy to Downtown Sounds.

#### MARY GOOPER

Working as a mother's helper, Mary Cooper relocated to Glen Cove from the South in 1956. It was love at first site. She came from a family of 15 children and once she moved to Glen Cove, she married and had two children of her own. Glen Cove won her over because she saw it as a family-oriented place. She now has grandchildren and great grandchildren in addition to many children and adolescents in the community that benefit from her wisdom. Her community work began with the Glen Cove Housing Authority and spread to the Glen Cove Youth Board of which she is an original board member. Working with the Youth Board lead to her involvement with the Business Improvement District and Downtown Sounds where she has been impressed with the progress that the series has made over the years. She also volunteers her time to SAFE, which provides drug prevention services to the community. Mary derives great satisfaction from volunteering because it allows her to help people. Celebrating her 80th birthday this summer, Mary's youthful exuberance and propensity to help others is an inspiration to old and young alike. "I don't like idle time," she explains. "I like staying busy and I like making people happy. So, volunteering my time to help the people of Glen Cove is perfect for me. I like to help the kids of today get the things that I wasn't able to get when I was their age. But I also teach them to appreciate what they have. I'm down in the dump sometimes, but people don't know it because I always stay positive."

#### EVE LUPENKO FERRANTE

Dr. Eve Lupenko Ferrante has been living in Glen Cove for over 30 years, and is so happy to have been invited this year to be on the committee for one of her absolute favorite summertime events. Downtown Sounds is one of the biggest community building activities. "I love starting the evening with dining downtown," she says, "then joining the hundreds of people joining together for an entire evening of fun including dancing in the streets!"

Dr. Lupenko is a board-certified dermatologist specializing in medical, surgical and cosmetic dermatology for both adults and children at Greenberg Cosmetic Surgery & Dermatology in Woodbury. She teaches dermatology residents at Columbia Presbyterian Hospital, and has been listed as a Top Doc in Newsday's Castle Connelly Awards for the past few years, and has been honored by nearly every large local newspaper organization, as well as local community service organizations for her dedication to her community.

In addition to giving speaking engagements at various health organizations, she is also a former Glen Cove City councilwoman, and currently sits on the Boards of the Beautification Commission, the Chamber of Commerce, Glen Cove C.A.R.E.S., the North Shore Historical Museum, and the Community Scholarship Fund. She is also a member of the North Shore Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, and is the founder of the Do Good to Feel Good Program.

She brings a theater and music background to the Downtown Sounds committee with her years of performing in community theater. In the past she was a co-owner of Eastline Studios, and she is still on the boards of the Glen Cove Arts Council and the Slayer Players Theatre Company where she is typically recognized for her recurring role as Alice Kramden in their Honeymooners series. # JOSE TROMBONE & CONJUNTO RUMBON AUGUST 11

Jose Trombone & Conjunto Rumbon are keepers of the iconic salsa gorda sound that emerged in New York City during the golden era of salsa. Jose Rivera is a long-time trombonist who started his music career with his family band in East New York. Jose was born in Puerto Rico and raised in both cultures. His father, Enrique Rivera, was a self-taught musician who was an influential pioneer in the NYC Salsa period. He established the family band with his wife and six children in the early 1960s. Jose, the oldest, started on percussion at age 6 and trombone at 13. He became his father's partner in composing their original music. As the family band evolved in the '70s, a fourth female musician joined, and later married Jose. The family band, Orquestra Los Juniors, became popular in the '70s and recorded two albums. Jose is currently the leader of Conjunto Rumbon and continues to arrange and integrate his original music into the performances.
